Example:

Secretary of Agriculture: Mark Reeves, Current position: Roommate

Duties: Advise me on what the best foods are to eat and how to shop/cook effectively.

Qualifications: Mark knows fruits and vegetables very well. He creates tasty drinks with his juicer for me every day. He also has an excellent garden plot that successfully grows 15 different plants. He is well informed on how things grow, and which foods are good to cook with each other. He will help me learn how to grill my steak so it tastes great and how to find the best prices for food at the different markets around town. Mark would also be a good Agriculture because of his 7 years work as a restaurant waiter.

TASK #2: Select *five* of the key current issues the United States is currently facing. Write a paragraph on each one briefly discussing what each issue is about, and what you would do if you were US President and had 100 days to work on it. Include which cabinet advisors you would call upon to help you successfully handle each issue.

Example:

Issue: Illegal Immigration Reform

Illegal immigration reform is concerned with how the US government should handle the thousands of people who come into our county from other countries. If I were US president, I would work to see that all of these people were given an opportunity to register with the government and pay taxes on the jobs that they work at. This would help people not get taken advantage of, and help pay for the government services they use while they are living in our country.
